LANGUAGE
ARTS

What are words and how can I use them? How can I speak well with others and know that I am using the right words? First graders see why words are important and how they can be used to create beautiful stories. Your first grader will experience the fun of communicating, learning, and expressing themselves.

MATH

<u>Build foundations through addition and subtraction operations.</u> Your child will count to 100 in different ways and describe and estimate quantities up to 20. They will relate numbers to their everyday life and find geometric shapes in their environment. Your child will solve problems related to numbers, patterns, and measurement.

SOCIAL STUDIES

What is a community? How do I fit in? What are some stories from the past? Your child will gain an understanding of the benefits and responsibilities of living in a community, while appreciating the differences of others. They will also explore the history of their family and community.

SCIENCE

<u>Do you know why fall is my favorite season of the year?</u> First grade science will foster your child's natural sense of wonder about the world as he learns about seasons, colors, and living things. Using his hands, his senses, and his mind, your child will make exciting discoveries and satisfy his curiosity.

HEALTH AND LIFE SKILLS

<u>I won't forget to wash my hands!</u> First graders see the importance of establishing healthy habits, eating well and following safety rules at home and at school. They understand that they can be good friends by taking turns, being kind and sharing. They also learn to set goals to work toward.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

What are the benefits of an active lifestyle? Your child will participate in a variety of activities that will help him or her lead a healthy and active lifestyle. He or she will grow to appreciate the importance of physical activity, while discovering essential life skills such as cooperation, leadership, fair play and teamwork.

ART/MUSIC

<u>How are things created?</u> In first grade, your child will create visual art using a variety of media and techniques and begin to think about the meaning of visual symbols.

<u>Let the music move you!</u> Your child will explore and describe the sounds around them, noting whether they are loud or soft. They will echo rhythms and express their feelings using action songs, singing games, and rhythm instruments.
